Tonight we were made aware that a middle school student has tested positive for COVID-19. It was determined the student was only a close contact to one other student. We have contacted the close contact and they will be required to quarantine for 14 days, even if they receive a negative test.

As always, we will be sanitizing our school once again. Please know that this is done on a regular basis. Before we came back to school this fall, the District purchased two machines that are very effective at killing 99.99% of all germs. These devices are used every day. In addition, we have purchased two portable sanitizing machines that our bus drivers use on a daily basis. I mention this because I want our families to know that we do take the health and safety of your children very seriously.
