Dear Families,

Today an elementary student, middle school student, 2 high school students, and a staff member have tested positive for Covid-19. Contact tracing has been completed with no additional students or staff identified as close contacts.

At this time, our quarantine guidelines are as follows:

- 1. Fully vaccinated individuals deemed a closed contact do not have to quarantine as long as they are not experiencing symptoms.
- 2. Regardless of vaccination status, when individuals are wearing masks properly and are 3 feet or more from the exposed individual, they do not need to be quarantined.
- 3. Students and staff not vaccinated, not wearing a mask, and who are within 6 feet of an individual for 15 cumulative minutes who test positive, will be quarantined for a minimum of 10 days. Close contacts will quarantine a minimum of 7 days and may return with a negative test on the 8th day, or quarantine for the full 10 days without a test.
