Dear Families,

Two high school students tested positive for Covid-19 on January 4th, and on January 5th, one high school student tested positive for Covid-19. Contact tracing has been completed with 6 additional students identified as close contacts. These students and their families have been made aware that they will need to continue to quarantine.

At this time, our quarantine guidelines are as follows:

- Fully vaccinated individuals deemed a closed contact do not have to quarantine as long as they are not experiencing symptoms.
- 2. Regardless of vaccination status, when individuals are wearing masks properly and are 3 feet or more from the exposed individual, they do not need to be quarantined.
- Students and staff not vaccinated, not wearing a mask, and who are within 6 feet of an individual for 15 cumulative minutes who test positive, will be quarantined for a minimum of 10 days.
